

Cthulhu French Press Cozy

Abbreviations:

- Ch – Chain
- Sc – single crochet
- Dc – double crochet

Materials:

- 1 Skein Color A (I used I Love This Yarn Sport Weight Yarn in Black)
- 1 Skein Color B (I used I Love This Yarn Sport Weight Yarn in Green)
- Black felt
- Black tread
- 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ inch diameter buttons (I used Le Bouton, Antique Gold)
- 1.80 mm Crochet Hook
- Sewing needle
- Yarn needle for finishing



Pattern Notes:

- Cthulhu is public domain, but this pattern is not. You are free to make as many cozies as you wish, incorporate them into other designs, or even sell them. However, you may not post this pattern anywhere else, nor may you sell this pattern.
- In the corresponding chart, color A is represented by white squares, while color B is represented by black squares. Each square represents one single crochet.
- Yardage: 150-160 yards
- Gauge: 1 inch is 6 stitches or 5 rows

Pattern:

1. In Color A. Ch 34
 2. Sc in second ch from hook. Sc in next 32 ch. This corresponds with row 1 in the chart.
 - 3-65. Ch 1. Turn. Sc across. Change colors according to chart on next page.
- Fasten off. Weave in ends.

To make buttonholes:

Join Color A in fourth sc of last row. Ch 1.

1. Sc 8.

2-12. Ch 1. Turn. Sc 8. (Note: Depending on your French press, you may need to add or remove rows here.)

13. Ch 3. Dc 2. Ch 4. Skip next 4 sc. Dc in next 2 sc.

14. Ch 1. Sc in next 2 Dc. Sc 6 in ch-4 space. Sc in next 2 sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Repeat in 20th sc of the last row of the main piece.

Finishing Instructions:

Cut black felt in a 10"x5" rectangle. Sew to back of cozy.

Sew buttons on opposite side of cozy from button holes.

Place on French press. Brew coffee.

Embrace the dark, caffeinated descent into madness.
