

Mason Jar Pin Cushion

Materials:

- 1 skein Red Heart Soft Yarn in Waterscape
- 1 mason jar
- A length of ribbon
- Hot glue gun
- Stuffing
- F-5 crochet hook
- Yarn needle for finishing

Pattern Notes:

- I own this pattern. This pattern is mine. You are free to make as many pin cushions as you wish, incorporate them into other designs, or even sell them. However, you may not post this pattern anywhere else, nor may you sell this pattern.
- I used a mason jar that was approx. 2 ½ inches in diameter, as measured across the top. If you use a different sized mason jar, this pattern won't work without some adjustment
- Gauge: 1 inch is 6 stitches or 5 rows. Gauge is very important for this project, or the pin cushion may not properly fit around the lid!
- Yardage: 20-30 yards

Abbreviations:

- Mc – magic ring
- Sc – single crochet
- Sl – slip stitch
- Ch – chain

Anatomy of a mason jar (or, important terms for finishing instructions):



Pattern:

Base:

1. In mc, Sc 6. Sl in first sc.
2. Ch 1. Sc 2 in each sc around. Sl in first sc. (12 sc)
3. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next sc) around. Sl in first sc (18 sc)
4. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next 2 sc) around. Sl in first sc (24 sc)
5. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next 3 sc) around. Sl in first sc (30 sc)
6. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next 4 sc) around. Sl in first sc (36 sc)
7. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next 5 sc) around. Sl in first sc. Fasten off. Weave in ends. (42 sc)

Top:

1. In mc, sc 6. Sl in first sc.
2. Ch 1. Sc 2 in each sc around. Sl in first sc (12 sc)
3. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next sc) around. Sl in first sc (18 sc)
4. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next 2 sc) around. Sl in first sc. (24 sc)
5. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next 3 sc) around. Sl in first sc. (30 sc)
6. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next 4 sc) around. Sl in first sc. (36 sc)
7. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next 5 sc) around. Sl in first sc. (42 sc)
- 8-11. Ch 1. Sc in each sc around. Sl in first sc. Do not fasten off.

Finishing instructions:

1. Place lid of mason jar on top of base. In back loops of top and front loops of base, sc around. When approx. $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way around, stuff firmly. Sl in first sc of round. Fasten off. Weave in ends.



2. Hot glue base of pin cushion to the top of the outer ring.



3. Hot glue ribbon around outer ring.
4. Optional: Decorate mason jar as you see fit
