

Tiny Crochet Hat

Materials:

- Worsted weight yarn
- Ribbon
- Two Barrettes
- Size G crochet hook
- Hot glue gun
- Yarn needle for sewing

Pattern Notes:

- I own this pattern. This pattern is mine. You are free to make as many tiny hats as you wish, incorporate them into other designs, or even sell them. However, you may not post this pattern anywhere else, nor may you sell this pattern.

Abbreviations:

- Mc – Magic ring
- Sc – Single crochet
- Sl – Slip stitch

Pattern:

1. In mc, sc 6. Sl in first sc
 2. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc)x6. Sl in first sc
 3. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next sc)x6. Sl in first sc
 4. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next 2 sc)x6. Sl in first sc
 5. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next 3 sc)x6. Sl in first sc
 6. Ch 1. In back loops only: Sc in each sc around. Sl in first sc
 7. Ch 1. Sc in each sc around. Sl in first sc
 8. Ch 1. Sc in each sc around. Sl in first sc
 9. Ch 1. Sc in each sc around. Sl in first sc
 10. Ch 1. Sc in each sc around. Sl in first sc
 11. Ch 1. Sc in each sc around. Sl in first sc
 12. Ch 1. In front loops only: (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next 4 sc)x6. Sl in first sc
 13. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next 5 sc)x6. Sl in first sc
 14. Ch 1. (Sc 2 in next sc. Sc in next 6 sc)x6. Sl in first sc
- Fasten off. Leave long end for sewing.

Finishing instructions:

1. Sew two barrettes onto the underside of the hat.
2. Cut a length of ribbon long enough to wrap around the hat.
3. Hot glue the ends of the ribbon together and place on hat, forming a hatband.
